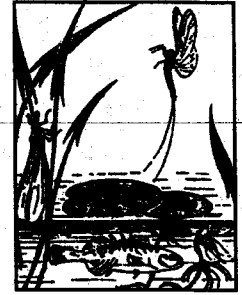

Dear Mr. Duncan:

As per your instructions, I conducted a botanical survey of four sites along the Twelve Mile Bay Road, in the vicinity of the O'Donnell Point Nature Reserve and the Moose Deer Point First Nation's Territory. This survey took place on August 2, 2002, and I was accompanied by Mr. Bart Brown, an Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources (OMNR) employee, who assisted in locating the subject sites and recorded our progress on aerial photographs.

In general, all of these sites are typical of the Georgian Bay Coastal Fringe, in that they exhibit shallow acidic soils with extensive protrusions of water-worn Precambrian Shield rock. This predisposes these sites to a set of predictable botanical assemblages dependent on soil moisture and depth characteristics. Specifically, upland sites tend to support white pine/red oak forests in which scrub white oak features as a significant component. Lowland sites, where soil depth permits, support red and silver maple dominated forests.

The primary focus of the botanical survey was to determine the presence, or absence, of any rare, threatened or endangered species of plants. These significance categories would roughly equate with the OMNR's, Natural Heritage Information Centre's, S1, S2 and S3 rankings respectively. Using these parameters, no botanical species were observed which would fit any of the aforementioned significance categories. I also compared the botanical species observed against a regional rareness list compiled by Mr. Bill Crins, OMNR senior research ecologist, in 1995. During this comparison, one species of grass, Smith's Melic Grass (*Melica smithii*) — Site #1 — was found to carry a significance status of "regionally rare" in Hill's Site Region 5E7.

As you are aware, several other species of rare plants have been previously reported in the vicinity of the four subject sites. Specifically these are: Southern Twayblade (*Listera australis*), Panicked Screwstem (*Bartonia paniculata*), Smith's Three-square (*Scirpus smithii*), Yellow-eyed Grass (*Xyris difformis*), and White Fringed Orchid (*Platanthera blephariglottis*). None of these species was observed, nor did any of the subject sites exhibit suitable habitats for any of these rare species — Southern Twayblade is usually found in conifer swamps, while the remaining species are associated with bog or fen types of wetlands.

The richest site observed was Site #1, which was primarily a deciduous lowland forest surrounding a small back bay connecting to Twelve Mile Bay. In total, 142 species of plants were observed at this location. The other three sites were less diverse in species richness, owing to the predominance of shallow soils and a primarily coniferous, forest overstory.

The attached tables list the species observed at each of the subject sites. The exact location of each of the four survey sites is recorded on the aerial photographs in Mr. Brown's possession. It should be noted that more species would be evident on these sites, if standard three-seasons botanical surveys were conducted, however, it is unlikely given the existing soil and forest conditions that any other provincially or nationally rare species would be discovered.
